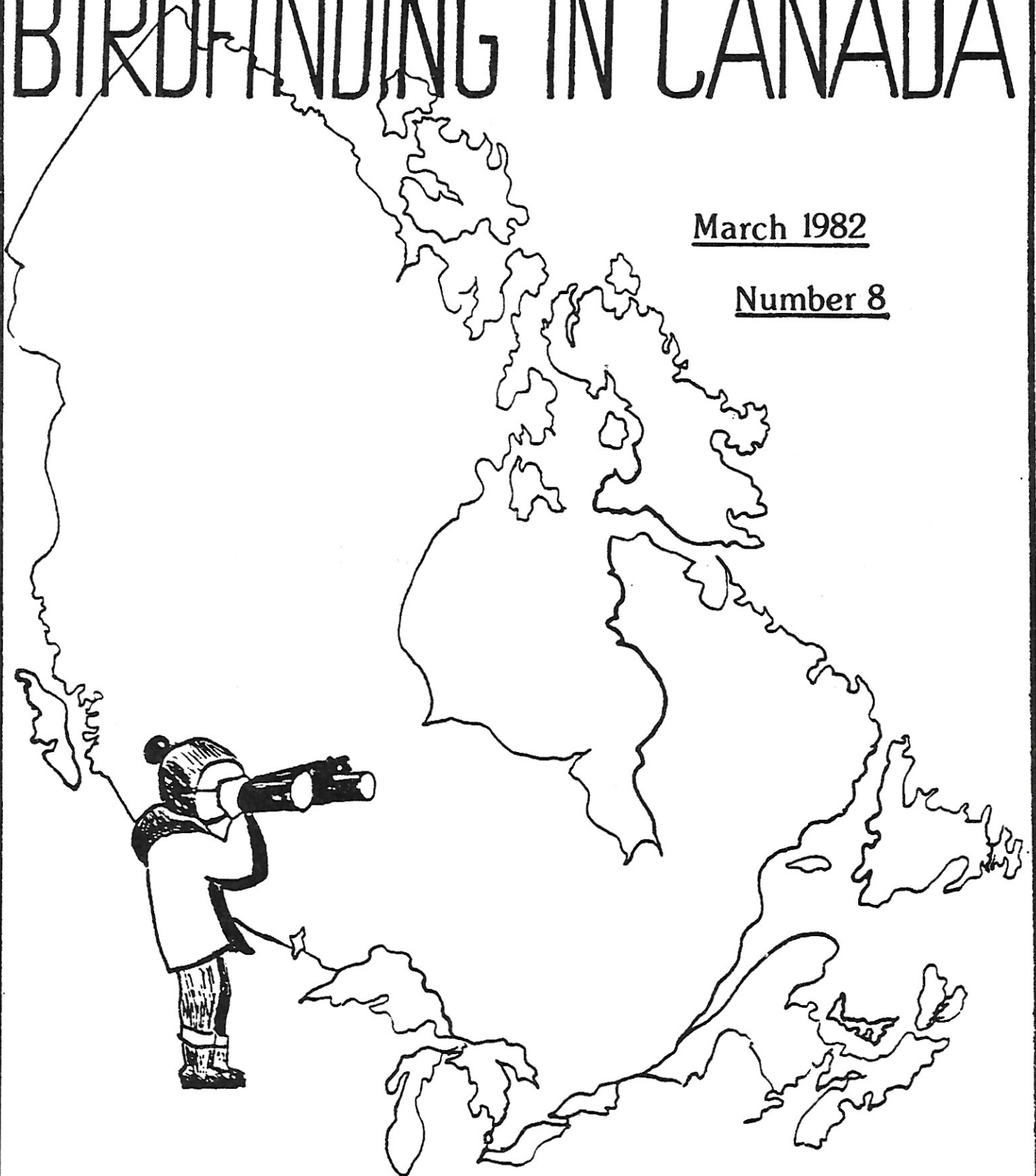

The bird whose name contains all five vowels but only one of each is the "æjəʊwɪə" *æjəʊwɪə*

There are at least 16 other birds on the Canada checklist whose English names contain all 5 vowels (but not necessarily just one of each) -- how many can you think of without looking them up?
