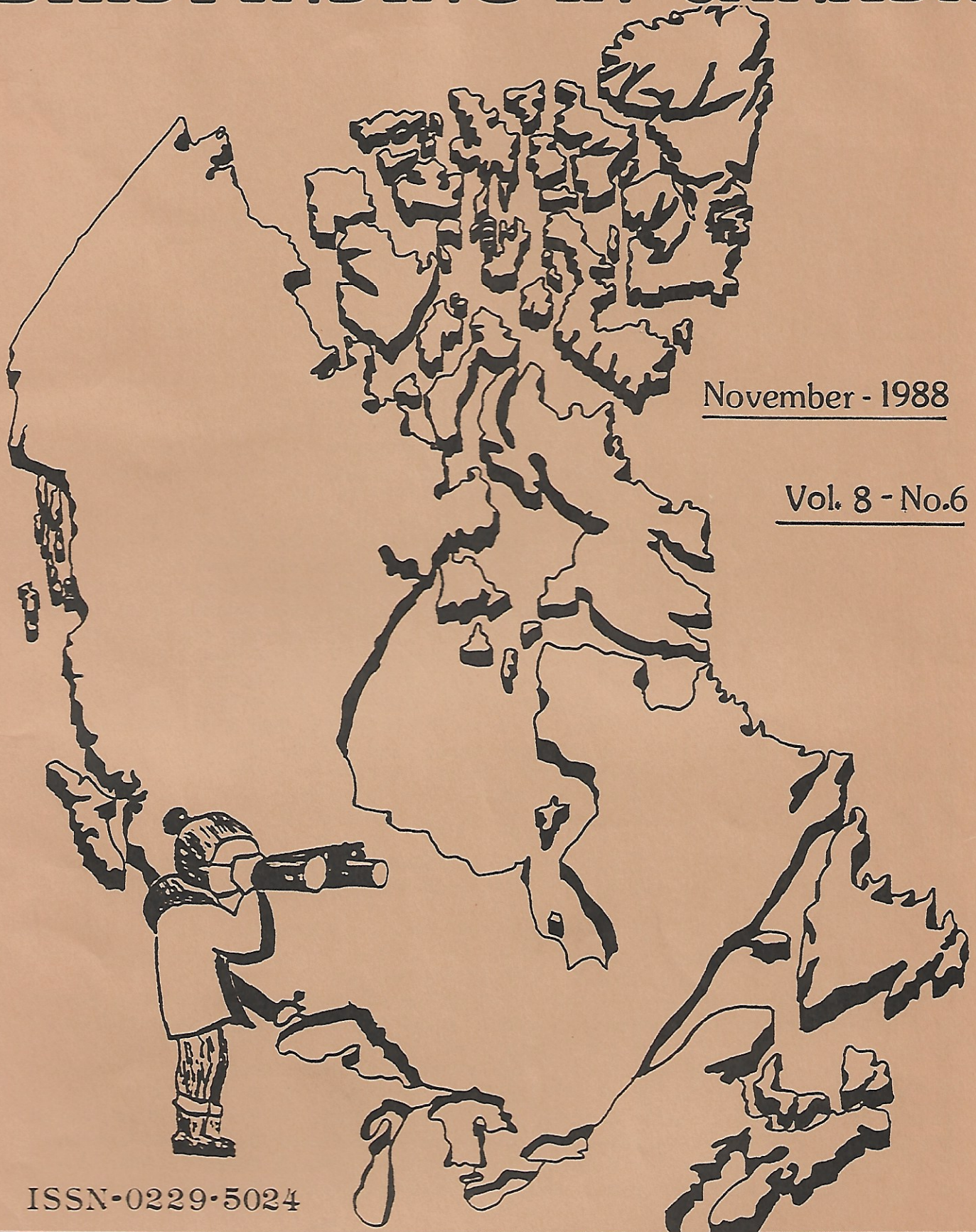

In our May '88 issue, we casually reported that George Cheeseman, of Edmonton, had a life list of 3 species for Hong Kong's Mai Po Marsh.

Wouldn't you know, someone has more. David Stirling of Victoria, B.C. advises that he ran up 35 species at Mai Po in 4 hours.

But, based on species per minute, George can still boast of his total, as he ran up his 3 birds in just 5 minutes. They were Common Kingfisher, White-throated Kingfisher and Pied Kingfisher. This works out to adding one life-list kingfisher every 100 seconds.
