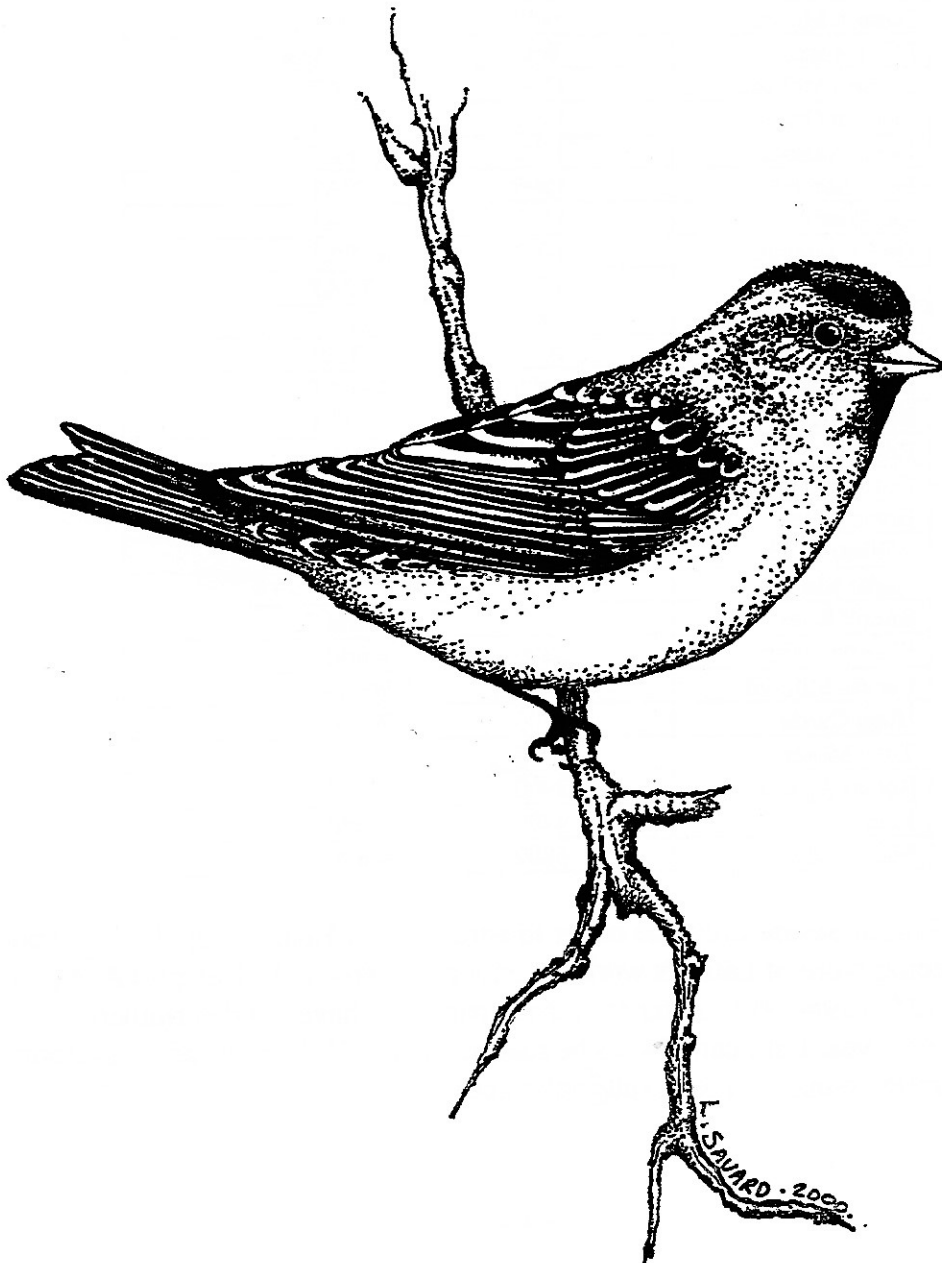

After my Africa trip I still have not determined where I will spend the next year but I can always be reached at 119 Holland Road, Saskatoon, SK, S7H 4Z5 or through e-mail: [burkekorol@yahoo.com](mailto:burkekorol@yahoo.com).

A few subscribers requested that I provide a summary of my trip to Africa, so here goes. I landed in Cape Town in October and spent the next five weeks driving eastward towards Johannesburg. A pelagic trip off of the Cape of Good Hope and visits to the Great Karoo, the highlands of Lesotho and the reserves of KwaZulu-Natal and Swaziland were highlights. Once in Johannesburg I joined two other birders and we spent the next three weeks in Kruger National Park and the Eastern Highlands of Zimbabwe. After a week in Harare I took an overland tour to Kenya. Once in Kenya I spent a week in classic African savannas of Masai Mara and Samburu National Park. I then flew back to Johannesburg and went north (narrowly missing the torrential rains that devastated Mozambique) towards Botswana's Chobe National Park. After a week there I traveled west through the Kalahari Desert to Namibia's Etosha National Park. Then I headed to the Atlantic Coast and then south to Namaqualand in northwestern South Africa and back to Cape Town.

The birding was beyond my greatest expectations and I managed to see over 750 species with about 700 of them being lifers. Crab Plover, Cape Sugarbird and Southern Ground-hornbill were some of my favourites. I added 23 new families of birds and saw 160 of southern Africa's 165 endemics. Eighty species of mammals wasn't bad either. If anyone is interested in a detailed trip report, please ask. If you are considering going to this part of the world, don't hesitate to do so. I traveled by myself most of the time and had no trouble with logistics, personal safety or health.

Again, I will be using North American totals from the Tony White Birder's Newsletter (formerly Birdlist Quarterly) which is current up to November 1999. Next year I will be switching from Clements' 4<sup>th</sup> edition world list to the 5<sup>th</sup> edition. There will be fewer recognized species worldwide but there will be more families of birds and your lists will need to be adjusted accordingly.

To be published a birder needed a life list of 40% of the provincial/territorial total in Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland or the three territories, and 50% of the provincial total in the other provinces. Thresholds are 350 for Canada, 500 for the ABA area, and 1000 for the ATPAT and world life lists. Thresholds are shown below, after an area's total list. Life lists are the most recent entries that I received up to the end of 1999. I did not receive lists for 1999 from those marked with an asterisk. Figures in parentheses following a birder's name are increases reported since last year.

This year's report includes threshold-breaking lists from 109 birders, which is down five from last year and includes 15 people from that I hadn't heard from by the time this issue went to the printer. Eighty-three birders have made the Canadian threshold, which is down six from last year. In 1999, two fewer birders crossed the ABA and world thresholds and those totals now stand at 66 and 39, respectively. The 39 ATPAT lists reported here is three less than last year. Despite a net loss of three lists, Ontario was again the province with the most birders (63) making its threshold.

Last year Rick Toochin added two birds to his British Columbia list (425), which is the top provincial list in Canada. Don Perks reported the top Ontario list (412) and Blake Maybank has 375 species in Nova Scotia. There have been no changes to the list of birders who have seen over 300 species in two or more provinces.

Eleven birders have made the cutoff threshold in five or more provinces/territories (Hue MacKenzie, Angus MacLean, Larry Neily in 5; Brooke Clibbon in 6; David Stirling in 7; Roger Foxall in 10; Alex Gray, Blake Maybank, Wayne Neily and Eric Tull in 11). By crossing the NB threshold, Peter Mitchell was added to the 'five or more' group. Changes to the provincial total for Nova Scotia resulted in the 'loss' of that province for Eric Tull. In 1999 Brooke Clibbon crossed the Northwest Territories threshold and David Stirling surpassed both the Saskatchewan and Ontario minimum requirement. Of birders who had already passed a provincial threshold, the biggest increases over last year were 17 (David Stirling in MB), 25 (Brooke Clibbon in BC) and 27 (Eric Tull in NT).

For the second year in a row, the top published Canadian life lists (510) belong to Surrey's Jo Ann and Hue MacKenzie, who each added three ticks. Newcomer Michael Bentley has joined the elite 500+ club for Canada. It must have come as a great relief to Mike Austin to see that Eurasian Oystercatcher at Eastport, NF on 1 May 99. This bird put him at 800 species for the ABA Area but he found two more species last year to reach the enviable total of 802. As usual, Martin Edwards added to his world list and continues to creep up on the late Phoebe Snetsinger's world record.

Largely due to a newly reported Ontario total, Surrey's Danny Tyson had the biggest increase in a Canadian life list in 1999 and easily passed the 400 species mark for our country. Rudolf Koes added 33 new species to his ABA list and this put him well over the 600 mark. Undoubtedly due, in part, to the Nunavut split, some large increases in ATPAT totals were reported last year. Peter Mitchell added 132 ticks, Brooke Clibbon improved by 243 and Richard Cannings added 311. The ATPAT 'heavyweights' crept closer to the 3000 mark, led by Eric Tull's increase of 93.

Despite not hearing from four world family listers for the past two years, 18 people are still reporting in this category, with the help of Martin Bowman and Gillian Horgan. Hugh Currie is now tied for second place and is moving towards Martin Edwards' perfect record for all of the world's families. By adding families like bustards, sandgrouse, African barbets and honeyguides, my 23 new families was the biggest improvement from the 1998 totals.

## YEAR LISTS

Year lists given here are a birder's best ever year list as well as the birder's 1999 year list. Year list cutoff thresholds were 30% of the provincial/territorial list for Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland and the three territories; 40% for the other provinces; and 80% of the life list cutoff for Canada, ATPAT, ABA area and the world. Thresholds are shown after an area's total list. Seventy-five birders made the cutoffs for one or more year lists, which is five less than last year. Canada (51), Ontario (36) and British Columbia (29) were the most popularly reported areas.

Currently, Ontario has nine and British Columbia has 11 birders who have seen at least 300 species in one year. Michael Bentley dusted off his notes and now holds the record for the highest provincial year list, which had been held by Rick Toochin for the past two years. In 1988 Michael observed 346 species in British Columbia. To my knowledge, this is the biggest provincial year list ever reported in Canada. Big provincial year lists from 1999 included 316 in BC (Rick Toochin), 273 in AB (Joan McDonald), 251 in SK (Burke Korol), 287 in MB (Rudolf Koes), 311 in ON (Craig McLauchlan), 256 in NS (Joan Czapalay) and 127 in NT (Eric Tull).

Last year Roger Foxall tied Gerry Bennett's all time highest Canada year list but that record has been shattered. In 1999, BC's Michael Bentley found 442 species in Canada and he is now the record holder. The next highest Canadian list from last year was exactly 100 species less than this! There were no noteworthy changes to ABA year lists. Martin Edwards' 1190 world species in 1999 was about half of his amazing 1998 total.

## DAY LISTS

As with year lists, a birder's best ever day list and the birder's best day list for 1999 are both reported. To be published, day lists had to make thresholds of 20% for Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland and the three territories, and 30% for the other provinces. Thresholds are shown after an area's total list. Fifty-three day lists (a decrease of six lists) are reported here from 32 birders. A nine year old record for a big day in Quebec was eclipsed by one species by Daniel St-Hilaire's total of 143. The all-time best days, in Manitoba, remained unsurpassed but last year Manitoba's Rudolf Koes and Gordon Grief, continued their annual ritual and tallied 192 and 189 species, respectively. Other big days from last year were from Ontario (Margaret Bain, Ian & Gavin Platt - 161) and the Northwest Territories (Eric Tull - 69).

## \*\*\*\*\* WINTER LISTS \*\*\*\*\*

Winter lists cover the period from 1 December to 28 (29) February. Winter life lists - the birds seen during those months in any year - are reported as of the end of 1999. Single winter lists are of species seen during one winter. Listed are a birder's best ever single winter list and the birder's list for the winter of 1998/99. The thresholds for winter life lists were 25% for Canada, British Columbia and Ontario; 15% for Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland and the three territories; and 20% for the other provinces. Thresholds for single winter lists were 5% less. Thresholds are shown after each category in all provinces and territories. Fifty-three birders submitted winter lists (down by four) that met or exceeded these thresholds. The top winter life lists are from Don Perks (261) in ON, Wayne Weber (244) in BC, Blake Maybank (207) in NS and Mabel McIntosh (178) in PQ. There were few changes to the top winter life lists in the Prairie Provinces but Joan McDonald managed to add five species to her current total of 132 in Alberta. Jo Ann MacKenzie continues to have the highest Canadian winter life list and after adding four species hers now stands at 285. David Milsom had a good winter by getting 17 new birds for his Canadian winter life list and establishing a new single winter high (157) for Ontario. In 1998/99 Joan McDonald barely missed her last winter's mark for Alberta. Rudolf Koes set a new standard for Manitoba by finding 81 birds last winter. My 183 Canadian species from last winter was well short of Rick Tootchin's single winter record of 222 Canada (and British Columbia).

## LOCAL LISTS

For all but a few northern areas, the thresholds for local lists have been set at 150 for life lists and 120 for best year lists. Local life lists are reported for lists received up to the end of 1999. Local lists are organized on a province by province basis. This year 89 birders (down 5) met the threshold for 124 local areas (up by four). There were few changes to the top local lists but Don Perks added one in Toronto (now at 355), Rick Toochin added two in Vancouver (now at 347) and Mabel McIntosh added two in Montreal (now at 330). Rick Tyson now has over 300 in Vancouver and John Nickerson has reached that level on Cape Sable Island.
