Welcome to the 2003 edition of *Listers' Corner*, especially to newcomers Frank Pinilla from Richmond Hill and Guy Zenaitis from Montreal. This year I have revised the reporting areas for a number of local areas so please be careful where you report your lists. I can e-mail current local reporting area definitions to anyone who requests them. Thanks to everyone who provided information on the boundaries and authorities for their 'local patches'. Note the new official name and abbreviation for the province on Newfoundland and Labrador (NL).

Naturalists across the country will be saddened to learn of the passing of Steve Cannings on 10 January 2003. Steve and his three sons have made an enormous contribution to the knowledge of the natural history of British Columbia. I met Steve in July 1996 when he kindly showed me a Flammulated Owl nest site near his Penticton home. His son, Richard, wanted to be sure that one of his dad's lifetime goals appeared (i.e., 600 species in the ABA area) in print. On behalf of the readership, I offer my condolences to the Cannings' family.

***** LIFE LISTS *****

Again, I will be using North American totals from Tony White's Birding Newsletter, which is current up to November 2002. As with the ABA, Clements' 5th edition is the authority used for world species and families.

To be published a birder needed a life list of 40% of the provincial/territorial total in PEI, Newfoundland and Labrador and the territories and 50% of the provincial total in the other provinces. Thresholds are 350 for Canada, 500 for the ABA area, 800 for North America and 1000 for ATPAT and world life lists. Thresholds are shown after an area's total list. Life lists are the most recent entries that I received up to the end of last year. An asterisk (*) indicates that I did not receive that person's list for 2002. Figures in parentheses following a birder's name are increases reported since last year.

This year's report includes threshold-breaking lists from 109 birders, which is down eight from last year, and includes seven people that I hadn't heard from by the time this issue went to the printer. The number of birders that made the Canadian and ABA thresholds were each down by four and are now 86 and 71, respectively. Seventeen people submitted North American lists, which are reported in Listers' Corner for the first time. Forty-six of us are now declaring world life lists of at least 1000 species. The 44 ATPAT lists mentioned here are four less than last year. With the exceptions of Prince Edward Island and the territories, there were decreases in the number of lists reported from all provinces. The biggest drop was in Ontario, where six fewer totals were sent in.

Most of the top lists from each province were improved upon in 2002, but Robert Tymstra's 22 new species in Nunavut was the biggest increase. The long-staying Tropical Kingbird helped several of us Ontario listers, including Alan Wormington, improve our provincial totals. With 366 species, Guy Zenaitis now has the second highest total in Quebec. Last year Doug Phelan passed the 300 species milestone in Newfoundland and Labrador.

There are still only five birders that have made the cutoff in 10 or more provinces / territories, but by now having a reportable list from the New Brunswick, Alex Gray has made the threshold in 12 jurisdictions. Provincially, some of the biggest improvements over last year's lists were by Alan Fishkin (27 in AB), Bernard and Thérèse Goulet (24 in AB), Burke Korol (12 in ON), Harold Stiver (11 in ON) and Juliette Pellerin (10 in NB).

With three new species Roger Foxall now has the best reported Canadian list, which is 512. Mike Austin remains as the only subscriber with an ABA list over 800, but with 754 Mike Toochin has the highest list for a Canadian resident. Of the seventeen people that submitted a North American list, Hugh Currie's was highest. Last year I finally got to meet Martin Edwards, who continues to improve his world life list of over 7000 species. Fellow Kingston resident Paul Mackenzie is closing in on the 5000 world species milestone.

Gordon Grief and Gordon Payne posted the biggest increases (+14 and +11, respectively) in a Canadian life list in 2002. Also noteworthy were the six ticks added to Don Perk's Canadian total, which is now at 465. The biggest gain for an ABA list was submitted by Andrew Slater. Andrew writes: The birding highlight of my year was a trip in mid-May to southeast Arizona, where I gained 49 lifers. The most unexpected was Flame-colored Tanager in Miller Canyon, while the 50th that got away was Common Black-Hawk, which failed to appear in Aravaipa Canyon (or anywhere else). My 50th addition to my world life list was of the armchair variety: Wilson's Snipe.

Last year most of the world birders found something new but with over 500 ticks during their 3-week trip to Kenya, Eric Tull and Brooke Clibbon added the most. Hugh Currie's 451 new species were found in exotic locations like India and Peru. As usual, Martin Edwards increased his world tally again in 2002. The best ATPAT increases were from Thérèse Goulet (108), Bernard Goulet (137) and Don MacNeill (145). Eric Tull now needs fewer than 50 ticks to reach an ATPAT of 3000.

Thirty-one birders are now reporting world family totals, which is up four from last year. For the second year in a row, Harold Stiver had the biggest improvement in this category, which was nine families.

YEAR LISTS

Year lists given here are a birder's best ever year list as well as their 2002 year list. Year list cutoff thresholds were 30% of the provincial/territorial list for PEI, Newfoundland and Labrador and the territories, 40% for the other provinces and 80% of the life list cutoff for Canada, ATPAT, ABA area and the world. Thresholds are shown after an area's total list. Seventy-seven birders made the cutoffs for one or more year lists, which is three less than last year. As usual, Canada (45), Ontario (40) and British Columbia (26) were the most popularly reported areas.

The only provincial year list record to be broken was in New Brunswick, where Juliette Pellerin found 235 species in 2002. Several Alberta birders had excellent years in 2002, but Suzanne Benoit's total from 1989 remains unbeaten. Malcolm and Joan McDonald sent in the following comments regarding their recent Alberta big year attempt. Each year I wonder how we will ever add anything new to our Alberta list, but in 2002 I think the birding gods must have been smiling on us. We finally managed to see some real nemesis species such as Little Gull, Band-tailed Pigeon, Red Phalarope, Anna's Hummingbird and Smith's Longspur. The Anna's was on 30 October in Lethbridge with the temperature a bone-chilling -21° C and about 15 cm of snow. The folks there rigged up a light bulb and fixed it to the sugar water feeder as it was freezing solid. We were pleased with our Alberta year total of 292. In hindsight it could have been 300 but we hate owling and we were not able to go to Beaverhill Lake for shorebirds so we missed some key species. Robert Parsons had a good year in Manitoba (274), as did Joan Czapalay in Nova Scotia (266).

DAY LISTS

As with year lists, a birder's best ever day list and their best day list for 2002 are both reported. To be published, day lists had to make thresholds of 20% for PEI, Newfoundland and Labrador and the territories and 30% for the other provinces. Thresholds are shown after an area's total list. Fifty-nine day lists (an increase of two) are reported here from 33 birders (up one from last year). Robert Tymstra bettered his 1995 big day total in Nunavut by nine species in 2002, but otherwise there were no new records. Gordon Grief's single day total of 179 in Manitoba was noteworthy because it was done in July 2002. Other big days from 2002 were from Laurie Rockwell (146 in BC), Rudolf Koes (191 in MB) and Ian and Gavin Platt (171 in ON).

WINTER LISTS

Winter lists cover the period from 1 December to 28 (29) February. Winter life lists - the birds seen during those months in any year - are reported as of the end of 2002. Single winter lists are of species seen during one winter. Listed are a birder's best ever single winter list and their list for the winter of 01/02. The thresholds for winter life lists are 25% for Canada, British Columbia and Ontario, 15% for PEI, Newfoundland and Labrador and the territories and 20% for the other provinces. Thresholds for single winter lists were 5% less. Thresholds are shown after each category in all jurisdictions. Fifty-nine birders submitted winter lists (unchanged from last year) that met or exceeded these thresholds.

With 261 species, Danny Tyson now has the highest reported winter life list in BC. Despite visiting family back home for most of the past four Christmases, I finally managed to add a couple of winter lifers (Purple Finch and Long-tailed Duck) in Saskatchewan. The Smith's Longspur that wintered near Hamilton helped Alan Wormington notch his 270th Ontario winter lifer. The winter of 01/02 was kind to Blake Maybank, who added 10 species to his Nova Scotia life list. Murray Newell was the third Nova Scotia birder to find over 200 species in winter. Doug Phelan's 'retroactive' winter life list of 144 from Newfoundland and Labrador has established a new high in that province. There was no change in the top Canadian winter life list.

Like the temperatures, several single winter listing records were established in 01/02. Malcolm and Joan McDonald's new Alberta single winter record of 112 included a 7-hour drive to Cold Lake for a Common Eider and snowshoeing around the meadows at Bow Summit for White-tailed Ptarmigan. In Ontario Dave Milsom improved that province's single winter record (also his) by six species, which is now 163. Rose-Aline Chiasson beat Hilaire Chiasson's 99/00 New Brunswick record by six species, but Hilaire beat his old record by eight. Last winter, three Nova Scotia birders exceeded Murray Newell's total of 146, which was done in 99/00. Doug Phelan's 92 species in Newfoundland and Labrador in 01/02 bettered the existing record by 20.

For all but a few northern areas, the thresholds for local lists have been set at 150 for life lists and 120 for best year lists. Local life lists are reported as received by the end of 2002. This year 86 birders (down by 10) met the threshold for 151 local areas (up by seven). At 366, Alan Wormington continues to have the top local list (Ontario's Chatham-Kent/Essex/Lambton Counties), to which he added Brown Pelican, White-winged Dove and Tropical Kingbird. Joan McDonald found her 300th species in Calgary and Hugh Currie has the highest list (335) from the newly included Greater Toronto Area.
