

LISTERS' CORNER C. Eric Tull

It seems I have an address correction with each issue of <u>Canadian Birding</u>. Since the last issue, Brooke and I have moved to Calgary, and any lists, comments, etc. should be sent to me at:

5-97 Grier Place NE, Calgary AB T2K 5Y5.

Because of the move I was unable to prepare the year lists as I had anticipated, and instead have prepared the provincial lists to include all the additions I have received.

Percentages are again based on the provincial lists from the ABA listing totals. Cutoffs have for the most part been taken at 50%, but a cutoff of 55% was used for Ontario (where the number qualifying at that number was more than twice the number qualifying in any other province).

A cutoff of 40% was used in PEI, Nfld and the territories, because of the low numbers of people qualifying there and the difficulty in some cases of attaining a 50% cutoff.

Percentages are probably the fairest means of comparing lists between provinces, but two problems must be borne in mind --comparisons suffer if one total is more up-to-date than another, and a high percentage is more difficult to attain if a high proportion of the birds on the list are rare or accidental. For the latter reason I consider Newfoundland to be a difficult province in which to build up a good list.

Only three people have reported lists over 90% -- Bob Kreba (93%) in Saskatchewan and Rudolf Koes (91%) and Gordon Grieef (90%) in Manitoba. New Brunswick (David Christie at 89%) and Ontario (Alan Wormington at 89%) are pressing that mark and most

provinces have one or more people in the mid-to high 80s, including Roger Burrows' remarkable 87% in Newfoundland. The only person to have lists for two provinces over 80% is Harv Lane (SK and MB). The only units that do not have a list over 80% are PEI, the Yukon and the NWT — the only units that do not have any resident birders.


Just as 500 is an obvious Canadian challenge for Canada (was for Norm Chesterfield), 400 birds would appear to be a prime provincial challenge. British Columbia and Ontario appear to be the only provinces where such a mark may be possible, and the question is which will fall first. Alan Wormington (393 in Ontario) and Mike Force (392 in BC) are the frontrunners, and I suspect the 400 mark will be achieved before very long.

The 300 mark has been achieved in all but the same three units mentioned above, where the total lists for each are all under 300. While 300 means less in Ontario and BC, it is a mark to shoot for in the other provinces, and it is interesting to see people attaining it in more than one province.

Seven have achieved it in two provinces (Alex Gray, Peter Hamel, Jo Ann and Hue MacKenzie in ON and BC; Richard Klauke in AB and BC; Scott Escott in SK and ON; and Mabel McIntosh in PQ and ON) and two in three provinces (Roger Foxall in ON, NS and BC; and the author in BC, AB and ON).

The popularity of birding across Canada is also shown by the number of birders with multiple lists making the cutoffs. In addition to Wayne Neily and the author, who have made the cutoff in all political units, Roger Foxall and Blake Maybank have done so in 8, and Peter Hamel, Hue MacKenzie and Bruce Mactavish in 6 provinces/territories.
