


LISTERS' CORNER C. Eric Tull

This issue lists provincial totals; 339 lists have made the cutoff thresholds, 15 more than for the previous provincial tabulation. Thresholds of 50% have been used for all provinces except Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island, Yukon, and the Northwest Territories, where thresholds of 40% were used. Even with the lower thresholds these units had the fewest listers making the cutoffs.

The threshold for Ontario was reduced to 50% at the request of an out-ofprovince birder who felt he should have equal opportunity there as elsewhere. The reduction permitted six additional listers to make the cut, all of whom were from outside Ontario.

Provincial lists were again based on the ABA totals for the various provinces as given in their 1989 List Report (Winging It, March 1990). (Their 1990 List Report does not provide provincial totals.)

I am concerned that these totals are becoming less accurate. If you are involved with a provincial bird-records group or otherwise keep track of your provincial list, would you please send me that information when you submit your lists. Ideally I would like a group from across the country who could keep me posted on changes to the recognized provincial totals.

By no means did all listers send me updates of their lists at the beginning of this year. Comparisons between lists must thus be tempered by the fact that some lists are less up-to-date. In those cases where I have not received an update since the last publication of provincial lists (November 1, 1990), I have marked lists with an asterisk (*).

One question I have been asked is whether the lists are for a certain standard cutoff date, such as the end of the year. I have not been following this practice; rather I have been updating my database as I receive your lists, and producing the report based on the most recent reports that I have from each of you. This was Gerry Bennett's practice, and is the simplest for me to follow.

However, if birders would prefer that lists be reported for a cutoff date I could certainly do so. Please let me know what you prefer.

I have also marked some lists with a plus sign (+) for those cases where there was no previous listing for the observer for that province. This can mean either a new subscriber (or at least a new submitter) or that someone has newly broken the threshold for the province. They are all nice to see, and particularly welcome is Ray Cooke, the first lister from Prince Edward Island to submit a list.

The leadership changed in only two political units since the last publication. In the Northwest Territories Rolph Davis gained the lead when the previous leader ceased to be a subscriber to Canadian Birding. In Quebec Mabel McIntosh has picked up eight species to move into the lead.

David Christie in New Brunswick has joined the elite "gang of four" (with Bob Kreba, Rudolf Koes, and Gordon Grieef) who have attained 90% in a province. Several others are very close.

Ontario, which has more than twice as many listers breaking the threshold as any other province, also has more than twice as many listers (23) who have broken 80%.


However, of those listers making the thresholds, Saskatchewan has the highest percentage (32%) who have broken the 80% The next highest is Newfoundland where two of eight (25%) have reached 80%.

There are no changes to report in the listers who have achieved 80% or 300 species in two or more provinces, but Bruce Mactavish should be given honourable mention for having 83% (but not 300 species) in Nfld and

319 species (but not 80%) in Nova Scotia. Blake Maybank has reached the threshold in two new provinces, and Peter Hamel and David Stirling in one each, to give them 10, 7, and 6 provinces respectively in which they have reached the reporting plateau.
